GSA Advance Program Overview



- JF&T Platform – started April 2017
 - Call for applications - April through May 2017
 - Application categories – General Member, Committee Representative
 - Committees offered - Quality Improvement, World Sepsis Congress, World Sepsis Day, Strategic Resourcing, Communications
 - Application results –
 - 20 applicants
 - 6 continents, 11 countries
 - Backgrounds - MDs, RNs

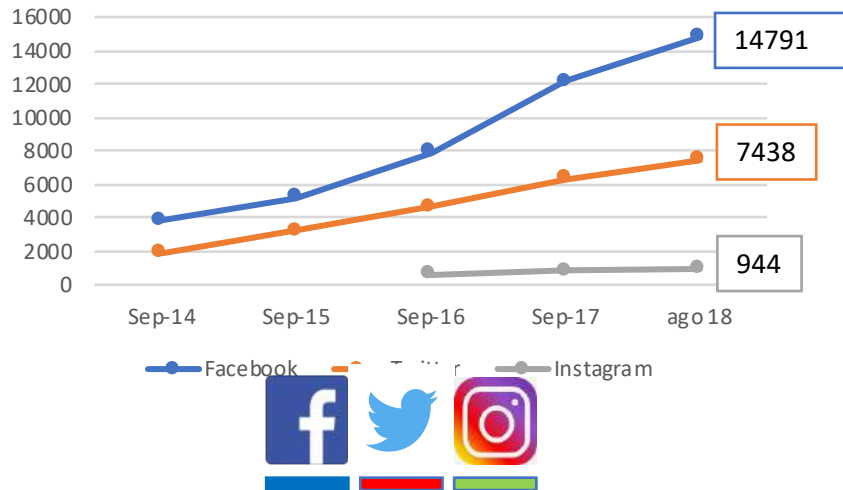

Sepsis Quality Measures Global Survey:

Purpose: Characterize sepsis surveillance, treatment, QI, and reporting practices worldwide.

Operates in 2 Arms:

- Public Survey (maximize reach) – Casts wide net for target respondents
- Officials Survey (maximize rigor) – Invitational, Health Ministers of WHO member states
